Good Learning Center (GLC)

The Good Learning Center (GLC) is a center that provides access to Information and Communications Technology (ICT), English Language, and learning resources. It is a comfortable environment that inspires and engages students to achieve quality education.

Each GLC consists of a library room, computer labs, an English class, and a library with study materials. The GLC supports teachers in scheduling classes and instructing ICT and English.

Goal

Provide inclusive equitable access to quality learning environments including digital learning.

Necessity of Project

(1). Students lack a proper environment for quality learning (2). Students have no opportunity to learn and practice ICT-related subjects, e.g. computer, internet, and email.

GLC COMPOSITION

English Classroom

Includes Tables, Chairs, a Set of Loud speakers, an LED TV (55"), White Board, and a competent teacher.

Modern Library

Includes Tablet Galaxy Tab (5 units), LED TV (55"), Computer (2 pcs), Bookshelf (3 sets), Reading Books (1000 Books), Librarian.

Computer Lab

Includes 25 Sets of Computer Labs (Monitors, Server UPS, Router), Computer Tables, Chairs, a Set of Loud Speakers, an LED TV (55"), and a competent teacher.



The Good Learning Center supports lecturers in ICT and English classes and advanced schedule management for classes and libraries to sustain learning effectiveness.

Each project school has about 300 to 500 students who use the GLC during school, and members of students' families (4 members per family) receive indirect benefits from the Good Learning Center.
